WHAT IS THE RED HAT AWARD & HONOR ROLL?

The Red Hat Award & Honor Roll was created by Gene & Rae Ellsworth in 1994 who made valuable contributions to the GWRRA Rider Education Program for many years on Chapter, District, Region and National teams. Their personal commitment to riding safety and skill lead them to provide a unique way to show appreciation to others. Directors' Emeritus Ray and Sandi Garris assisted with the program from its beginning and after Gene's passing, the Garris' became the Red Hat Coordinators retiring from the position in 2019.

Nominees may or may not have a direct role in Rider Education (including MFA) but have made positive impact on fellow Members on a one on one, Chapter, District or National basis and while nominations may be submitted any time during the year, most Red Hat Awards are presented during the GWRRA Awards Ceremony held the day before WING DING officially opens each year.

Awardees receive a Red Hat embroidered with the phrase, "Ride with Pride and Confidence", are assigned a unique honor roll number and recognized on the GWRRA Red Hat Honor Roll posted to the GWRRA website which is maintained by the Red Hat Award Coordinator. Awardee names and numbers may be added by the Honoree or their District at their expense. The Red Hat Honor Roll is maintained by the Red Hat Award Coordinator.

WHO IS RED HAT AWARD CANDIDATE?

Red Hat Award nominees are individual or couple who:

- are Members in good standing of GWRRA.
- may or not have served as Educators or Ride Coordinators at the District or Chapter level or as an instructor or trainer.
- have shown a special interest in the safety and education of their fellow GWRRA Members.
- have made valuable contributions to or performed exceptional acts to promote or preserve safety, knowledge and best practices.

Examples of Past Red Hat Awardees contributions:

- Awardees opened their home on a regular for use as classroom space for rider education instruction and training
- Awardee donated new equipment and supplies to enhance a District's RE Program
- Awardee used skills learned as MEDIC FIRST AID® participant to save a life

RED HAT AWARD SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

- Any Member may complete and submit a Red Hat Award nomination. It is not necessary for the nominee to be an educator, hold any position or be an instructor or trainer.
- Nomination forms from Members, Chapters or District Team Members will be forwarded to the District's Director. The Director and District Educator will review and sign the document.
- There is no maximum number of nominations that can be submitted by a District however, there is no guarantee all nominees will be recognized with a Red Hat Award.
